The following additional information was provided regarding the April 25 Board meeting agenda:

Item 3.a, Campaign for College Opportunity Sponsorship:

- Does NOCCCD currently have any formal relationship with the Campaign for College Opportunity?
 While the District does not have a formal relationship with the Campaign for College Opportunity,
 both Cypress College and Fullerton College have each received multiple awards from the
 Campaign over the past several years.
- 2. What benefits will NOCCCD get from being a Sponsor-level supporter? The sponsorship was made to support the Champions of Higher Education for Excellence in Transfer. This particular event is to honor California Community Colleges and CSU campuses for their outstanding work in leading the State in conferring the Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT), enrolling ADT earners on guaranteed pathways to a bachelor's degree, and intentionally working to support Latinx and Black students on their path to a degree. A Sponsor-level supporter will also receive print, verbal, and social media recognition for their sponsorship.
- 3. Why is this categorized as a hospitality expense rather than an institutional membership? This was a one-time expense made to support a campaign that hosts a series of events to help engage and inform a broad range of Californians to ensure our state leaders are addressing the needs of students by championing policies and practices to increase student access and success. This sponsorship would fall under BP 6350, Hospitality, section 1.1.13: Other activities to encourage public participation and awareness of college and district programs and activities through direct personal contact with individuals and community groups.
