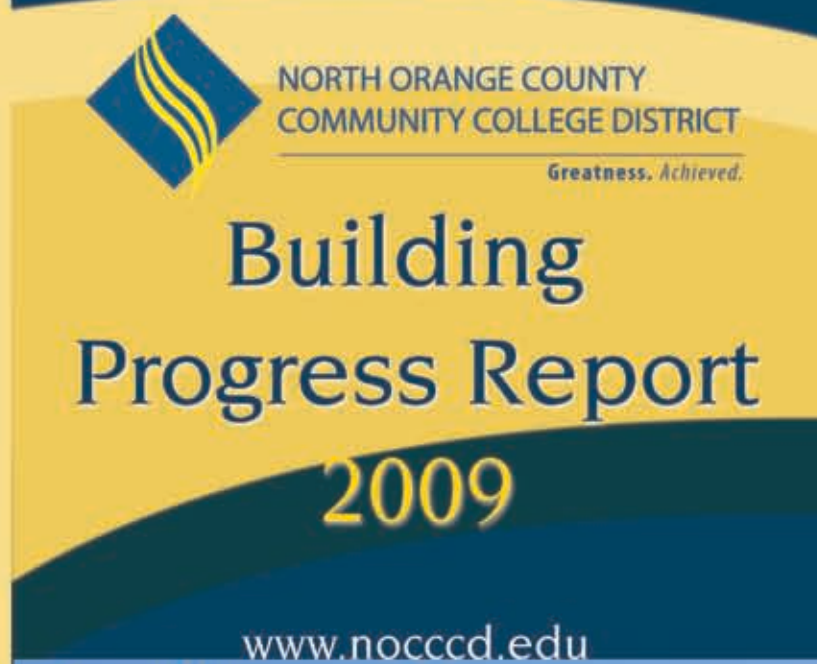

*Progress can be seen all around us – thanks to continuing work on the many campus projects in Measure X, with local funding approved by voters just over seven years ago.*


### Thank you to our communities!

### Cypress College Piazza/Infrastructure Repair

- 157,000 square feet
- Another “ground floor,” providing access between almost all campus buildings



### Cypress College Student Center/Bookstore

- 35,500 square feet
- One-stop location for students, including Admissions & Records, Bursar's Office, Counseling, Honor's Program, Transfer Center, Career Planning Center, and Food Services



### Fullerton College Classroom Office Building

- 38,283 square feet
- Home of Social Science Division and Reading Department



### Fullerton College Physical Education Complex Renovation

- 20,000 square feet
- Phase I – 50-meter swimming pool, completed in 2009
- Phase II – remodeling the physical education building, and field house and football field upgrade and renovation



### School of Continuing Education Wilshire Center

- 20,000 square feet
- 2009 Fullerton Heritage Preservation Award Winner, recognizing the best example of preservation and adaptive reuse building project in Fullerton
