Even prior to her start date, Dr. Marshall was a familiar face at many District-wide events, attending the spring "Coffees with the Board and Chancellor," meeting with constituencies, and participating in the hiring of Dr. Greg Schulz as Fullerton College's President.

During her first two official weeks with NOCCCD, she **joined Fullerton College administrators** to discuss the facilities master plan with neighbors and held a **Chancellor's Latino Community Advisory Committee** meeting to discuss pressing matters in our region.

In addition, she welcomed attendees to the July 6 **Baccalaureate Degree Pilot Program Summit** at Cal

State Fullerton. The all-day event provided an opportunity for over 160 faculty, staff, and administrators from California community colleges to learn from each other, prepare for upcoming accreditation visits, and continue to develop their curriculum, among others.

Lastly, Dr. Marshall spent an afternoon with SCE Interim Provost Valentina Purtell, meeting with SCE's deans and staff, and touring the school's three centers and its new North Orange County Regional Consortium (NOCRC) Office on Euclid Avenue in Anaheim.
