Measure J Update - Cypress College SEM Building



On Tuesday, August 23, the North Orange County Community College District Board of Trustees voted unanimously to expand the scope of the new Science, Engineering & Math (SEM) building at Cypress College. Though the project was originally approved by the Board in December 2015, information gleaned from the *Mid-Term Educational Master Plan Update* revealed that the College would need to increase the

size of the building from 100,000 GSF to 106,023 GSF to accommodate the growing needs of the program.

The Board also voted to enter into an architectural consultant agreement with LPA, Inc. for work that covers the design and construction of the building. The state-of-the-art facility is scheduled to open in 2020 and will replace an aging facility that is substantially unchanged from its initial 1960s design.

Human Resources Welcomes Amita Suhid



Register to Park at Cypress College

In an effort to help alleviate some of the stress placed on both students and staff when it comes to parking, Cypress College has made the switch to a license plate recognition program.

Your license plate at Cypress College is now your parking permit.

What does this mean for District-wide faculty and staff?

- All District-wide faculty and staff must register their license plates online if they plan to park at Cypress College. To register, log in to myGateway and click on "Cypress Parking System" in the Employees Links section.
- Fullerton College and Anaheim Campus Campus Safety Officers will check license
 plates if no placard is displayed. Fullerton College, SCE Wilshire, District Office, and
 SCE Anaheim employees should still continue to display their parking permits, in
 addition to registering the license plates.
